Time limits are displayed on on-street / kerbside signage, as a number followed by "P". "2P" for example indicates a time limit of 2 hours. In time restricted areas, it is illegal to return to the same section of road within 1 hour. One section of the road ends and another begins wherever an intersecting road occurs.

Accessible Parking

The City of Perth supports Disability parking permit holders with the provision of discounted parking in all City of Perth car parks. A 'Disability parking permit' consists of an Australian Disability Parking Permit and an ACROD Parking Program Card.

Pay for a minimum of 1 hour of parking, and receive up to two hours free parking. Time concessions apply for on-street (Kerbside) parking and these are explained below.

Accessible Parking Concession Conditions

- These concessions are applicable only to hourly rates and do not apply to block rates (12 hour etc.), discounted fees or event parking.
- To be eligible for concession both ACROD Parking Program Card and Disability Parking Permit need to be displayed.
- The permit holder must be in the vehicle, either as a driver or passenger.
- The City of Perth recognises valid international and interstate disabled parking permits.
- Out of date permits will not be accepted for a concession.
- These concessions are valid within the boundaries of the City of Perth only.
- For Disability parking outside the City of Perth please obtain the conditions applicable from the Local Council.

Parking Off-Street within a City of Perth Car Park

Parking Meter Car Parks (Pay-by-Plate)

Pay at a parking meter or on the parking payment app (EasyPark App) for a minimum of 1 hour, and display the valid Disability Parking Permit on the dashboard. The parking time will remain valid for a further 2 hours after the expiry time.

Boom Gate Car Parks

In boom gated car parks, pay for a minimum of 1 hour and then receive up to an additional 2 hours free parking.

When paying for your parking, please proceed to the payment station with a copy of your disability parking permit (either photocopy of front section only or photo image on your smart phone) and press the Assistance intercom button. Your concession can then be applied remotely by a Customer Service Officer who will ask for you to show the copy of your permit which they are able to view the expiry date via the cameras located at each of our payment station areas.

Alternatively, The Disability Parking Permit holders should pay the full fee and obtain a receipt, then post or email their receipt and a legible copy of the permit to City of Perth Parking for a refund.

Use of a ACROD Bay

Disability parking permit holders who do not require mobility assistance i.e. a wheelchair or walking frame, can park in any general bay within a car park and remain eligible for concessions, thus leaving the extra wide ACROD bays for customers requiring extra clearance around their vehicle.

Should any difficulties be encountered, please pay full fee and request a refund in writing by supplying a copy of the receipt and Disability parking permit.

Parking On-Street (Kerbside)

The City of Perth provides parking concessions on-street (Kerbside) for people with accessibility requirements who hold a valid Disability Parking Permit.

Kerbside parking bays are on-street parking bays controlled by green permissive parking signs e.g. ¼ P, 1P, 2P. There are three sign types: (a), (b) and (c).

a) Time restricted no fee payable (General Bays).

A vehicle displaying a valid Disability Parking Permit in a time restricted parking bay may park for:

- i. If the time limit indicated on the parking sign is under 30 minutes – for 30 minutes;
- ii. If the time limit indicated on the parking sign is between 30 and 60 minutes – for 2 hours;
- iii. If the time limit indicated on the parking sign is over 60 minutes – for twice the period indicated on the sign.

Once this time expires the vehicle must vacate the parking bay and may not return to the same section of road within 1 hour.

b) Time restricted fee payable (General Bays).

A vehicle displaying a valid Disability Parking Permit in a time restricted parking bay, where a fee is payable, must pay the minimum applicable fee and if required, fees for additional parking time. After the purchased time expires the vehicle may remain parked for the same time again but once this second period expires the vehicle must vacate the parking bay and may not return to the same section of road within 1 hour.

c) Time restricted (Accessible Parking bays only).

Parking in a time restricted accessible bay is limited to the period stated on the sign.

Please note: Concessions do not apply to restricted parking areas such as Clearways, Loading Zones, Bus Zones, Taxi Zones. Failure to adhere to the above conditions may result in a parking infringement being issued.

Unique Circumstances

While City of Perth Parking makes every effort to provide accessible parking, it is not possible to meet every circumstance. The City places a high degree of importance on making the parking experience a positive one for all customers and our customer service staff are always available on 1300 889 613 to discuss unique circumstances with our customers and devise a solution acceptable to all.

In addition to providing concessions, we aim to improve parking amenities for those with accessibility requirements.

Other Information

Electric Vehicle Charging

Electric vehicle charging facilities are available in dedicated electric vehicle bays at the following car parks: Citiplace, Concert Hall, Convention Centre, Council House, Cultural Centre, Elder St, His Majesty's, Mayfair Street, Pier Street, Regal Place and State Library. More information regarding the type of outlets is available on the individual car park pages on the City of Perth Parking website.

Motorcycle Parking

Motorcycle bays are provided at most car parks. These bays are marked specifically for motorcycle parking (inclusive of all motorised two-wheel vehicles) usage. It is an offence for motorcycles to be parked in bays designated for motor vehicles (i.e. cars, vans, trucks) unless a sidecar is attached. In most open air and some under cover car parks there are parking meters at the motorcycle bays.

Car Parks with Dedicated Motorcycle Entry System

City of Perth Parking has installed dedicated motorcycle entries at some car parks. These new motorcycle entries mean that motorcyclists can automatically redeem their motorcycle discount on parking fees by simply taking their parking ticket to the pay station to pay and validate.

In the car parks with no dedicated motorcycle entry, the motorcyclist presents the ticket obtained at the entry boom gate to the Customer Service Officer to obtain a motorcycle reduction on the car parking hourly fee.

Please note: No early bird or concessions apply to the already reduced motorcycle parking fees. To access the dedicated motorcycle entry, go to the motorcycle entry gate at the car park. Once there, ride up to the small motorcycle only boom gate, take a ticket from the dispenser unit and park in a designated motorcycle bay. Any ticket issued from the motorcycle entry can be paid at any auto pay station within the car park at the discounted rate. Remember that only tickets dispensed from the dedicated motorcycle entries are entitled to the discounted motorcycle rates.

Bicycle Parking

No fee payable except for Elder Street car park – all bicycles need to park in a designated bicycle bay.

At Elder Street car park, there is a dedicated bicycle parking area that can hold up to 54 bicycles.

The designated bicycle area has its own entrance with a turnstile gate located at the Elder Street side of the car park next to the motorcycle parking area. When approaching the gate, take a ticket from the dispenser unit, then enter via the turnstile gate and park bicycle in a designated bicycle bay.

Any ticket issued from the bicycle entry can be paid at any auto pay station. Only tickets dispensed from the dedicated bicycle entries are entitled to the discounted bicycle rates.

Maximum Time (Day & Night Rates)

The hourly rate applies either side of the day or night rate times, unless the next day or night rate becomes applicable.

How To Pay For Parking

EasyPark Parking Payment App

EasyPark is a parking payment app that you can use to pay for your parking in City of Perth pay-by-plate (non boom gate entry) car parks and on-street bays.

To get started; download the EasyPark app to your smart device, register your details with EasyPark, and start your parking session. Remember to end your parking session to ensure you only pay for the time you use.

The EasyPark app charges an additional service fee for users, with rates varying depending on whether you're a casual user or on a business account. This service fee goes to EasyPark, not the City of Perth.

Parking Meters (pay-by-plate)

Parking meters are located in pay-by-plate (non boom gate entry) car parks, certain boom gate entry car parks with dedicated motorcycle bays, and on-street bays.

To use the meter:

- Enter your vehicle registration number
- Select the required parking duration
- Pay with your card using tap-and-go, or with coins at cash accepting meters

Our parking meters are ticketless, so there's no need to display a ticket on your vehicle dashboard.

If you require a receipt, e-receipts are available from the online portal myparkingticket.com.au.

Automated pay machines (pay as you leave):

Automated payment machines are used in the following car parks: Concert Hall, Citiplace, Convention Centre, Cultural Centre, Elder Street, His Majesty's, Pier Street, Roe Street, State Library and Terrace Road. A ticket is issued at the entry boom gate. Before returning to the vehicle to exit the car park, customers must pay for their parking by visiting one of the automated payment machines. The machine will collect monies owing and validate the ticket. Customers can then return to their vehicle and exit the facility by inserting the ticket at the exit boom gate. If you require a receipt, press the 'receipt' option on screen at the machine when paying for your parking, and a paper receipt to be issued.

Licence Plate Recognition System:

Used in the following car parks: Goderich Street, Mayfair Street, Regal Place and Council House.

On entry to the car park, the boom gate will automatically open. The licence plate of the vehicle will be captured by a camera when entering. No ticket will be issued. The option to pre-pay for parking is available along with the option to pay when leaving.

The payment machines have a touch screen. Simply enter the licence plate number on the screen or the approximate time entering the car park to bring up images of the vehicle that matches the licence plate. Once selected, either press the pre-pay button or the pay for exit button to make payment. Payment can be made by cash, credit card or EFTPOS. Press on the screen for a receipt if required. If payment has been made to exit the car park, the boom gate will automatically open when the vehicle approaches the exit. If the boom gate does not open, press the intercom button for assistance.

Credit Card and EFTPOS facilities

Credit card (Visa, Mastercard, American Express) and EFTPOS facilities are available at all staffed City of Perth car parks.

Credit cards (Visa, Mastercard, American Express) are also accepted in unstaffed car parks via the parking meters or automated pay machines. This facility is also available at on-street ticket machines in the CBD and parts of West Perth, Northbridge and East Perth. A card surcharge applies to all accepted card payments. The minimum transaction amount is \$2 for vehicles. The minimum hourly fee applies for motorcycle parking.

If the credit card payment option is offline or the transaction cannot be completed, payment must be made with cash or EasyPark where available, or the customer must use another machine.

Terms & Conditions

General Terms and Conditions

By entering and using City of Perth parking facilities you agree to the terms set out below:

1. Whether you are a driver or a passenger in the vehicle to be parked you use this facility at your own risk.
2. The City of Perth is not responsible for your security, the security of your vehicle or any property brought into this facility.
3. The City of Perth does not accept any liability for any injury to you, or loss or damage to your vehicle or any other property.
4. You agree to release and indemnify the City of Perth from any liability that it may incur as a result of your use of this facility.
5. The City of Perth Parking Local Law 2017 applies to all users of this facility.
6. A person must not stop a motorcycle without a side-car or a bicycle in a parking bay or space unless:
 - (a) The bay or space is marked 'Motorcycle' or 'Bicycle'; or
 - (b) A sign applying to the bay or space is inscribed 'Motorcycle' or 'Bicycle'.
7. No additional concessions are applicable to motorcycle rates.
8. All display permits and Disability Parking Permits must be displayed face up on the dashboard at all times.
9. Promotional rates will be subject to limited availability where applicable.

Payment Terms and Conditions

Please note that a one hour minimum fee is applicable at all car parks and a \$2 minimum fee applies for on-street/kerbside parking. The \$2 minimum is not applicable if using the pay-by-phone app to purchase parking in pay-by-plate car parks and on-street/kerbside parking. A minimum hourly fee applies for motorcycle parking.

1. Applicable fees will be determined by:
 - (a) time of entry and duration of stay (for boom gated car parks); or
 - (b) time payment at parking meter or time parking session is started on EasyPark App and duration of stay (for pay-by-plate car parks); or
 - (c) time of payment and duration of stay (for motorcycles and Disability bays using parking meters).
2. For boom gated car parks, the hourly rate applies either side of the day or night rate times, unless the next day or night rate becomes applicable.
3. If the card payment facility is offline, or the card payment cannot be completed, customers must use cash if accepted or use the EasyPark App if available.
4. Selected credit cards accepted. Credit card fees may apply. See fee signage for details.
5. The City of Perth is not liable for any loss or inconvenience arising from the unavailability of payment facilities.
6. The City of Perth will not process refund claims caused by customers failing to follow the payment instructions displayed on the machines.
7. The City of Perth reserves the right to refuse certain note or coin denominations.
8. For boom gated car parks, lost or damaged tickets will be charged from 8.00am on the day of entry.
9. For boom gated car parks, ticket purchase is for single entry / exit only.
